AN ACT to Amend the University of the West Indies (Mona Campus)
(Security) Act.

15th July 2010

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows: -

1. This Act may be cited as the University of the West Indies (Mona Campus) (Security) (Amendment) Act, 2010, and shall be read and construed as one with the University of the West Indies (Mona Campus) (Security) Act, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

2. Section 13 of the principal Act is repealed and the following substituted therefor—

Prohibited
acts

13. A person shall not carry out any of the following acts on the Campus, without first being authorized to do so by the Committee, that is to say—

- (a) cut trees, plants or other vegetation;
- (b) take trees, plants or other vegetation or take fruits or other parts therefrom;
- (c) set fires or remove growing trees, plants or other vegetation;
- (d) lay or put up any wire, cable, fence, pipeline, net or any other material; or
- (e) dig, excavate, bore or lay any road, track or path.”.
