THE PENSIONS ACT

The Pensions (Amendment of Schedule) Regulations, 2012

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Minister by section 3 of the Pensions Act, and every other power hereunto enabling, the following Regulations are hereby made:-

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Pensions (Amendment of Schedule) Regulations, 2012, and shall be read and construed as one with the Pensions Act and all amendments thereto.
- 2. Part III of the Appendix to the regulations set out in the Schedule to the Act is amended -
 - (a) in paragraph 2 by deleting sub-paragraph (h) and inserting the following as sub-paragraphs (h) to (k) -
 - '(h) in respect of an officer who dies from injuries received on or after the 1st day of April, 2000, but before the 1st day of April, 2005, not exceed -
 - (i) four million dollars; or
 - (ii) the aggregate of the amounts specified in sub-paragraph (a) (iii),

whichever is the greater;

- (i) in respect of an officer who dies from injuries received on or after the 1st day of April, 2005, but before the 1st day of April, 2006, not exceed
 - four million five hundred thousand dollars; or
 - (ii) the aggregate of the amounts specified in sub-paragraph (a)(iii),

whichever is the greater;

(j) in respect of an officer who dies from injuries

received on or after the 1st day of April, 2006, but before the 1st day of April, 2008, not exceed -

- (i) six million dollars; or
- (ii) the aggregate of the amounts specified in sub-paragraph (a) (iii),

whichever is the greater;

- (k) in respect of an officer who dies from injuries received on or after the 1st day of April, 2008, not exceed -
 - (i) eight million dollars; or
 - (ii) the aggregate of the amounts specified in sub-paragraph (a)(iii),

whichever is the greater.";

(b) by deleting paragraph 3.
